The goal of this seminar is to help municipalities and engineering firms understand the steps needed to insure the successful completion of a trenchless construction project. The program targets the many field application nuances that are unique to different trenchless products and procedures. The course will teach attendees to create benchmarks for inspection during the course of a project that will help enable them to avoid costly, discouraging or dangerous failures.
